

Program Description Substance Abuse Services

Each client shall receive services each week. The services shall include counseling as provided for in subsection 65D-30.010(2), F.A.C. Clinical staff shall provide those services. Services shall be provided in accordance with the needs of the client as identified in the treatment plan.

Other areas of focus may include: (a) Life skills training such as anger management, communication skills, employability skills, problem solving, relapse prevention, recovery training, decision-making, relationship skills, and symptom management; (b) Non-verbal therapies such as recreation therapy, art therapy, music therapy, or dance (movement) therapy to provide the client with alternative means of self expression and problem resolution; © Training or advising in health and medical issues; (d) Employment or educational support services to assist clients in becoming financially independent.
